The tragedy we experienced in Norway (in which James Witham was killed in a hiking incident) continues to be a key moment as we experience God and live out our lives for Him. Amidst the pain we felt God promise to give us others in exchange for his life (as per the verse above). Our expectation was that this would be primarily new students joining our ministry but much to our surprise God had other plans. We are therefore thrilled to announce we are expecting another boy in May 2014. Please do pray for Debs in these final months of pregnancy and for the whole family as we adapt to the changes that this will bring.

We give thanks that Benjamin (who has just turned 5 years old) has settled so well into school and that Naomi (3¼ years old) is enjoying her time at pre-school and ballet. Samuel (1¼ years old) also seems to have grown up considerably and all of a sudden has become quite the grown up little boy. He did however suffer over Christmas and was taken into hospital at 5am on Christmas day with Bronchiolitis. Though he missed out on the turkey, thankfully the hospital discharged him later that afternoon and he has now made a full recovery.

In terms of ministry we look forward to the new year with excitement. We remain very grateful for the fantastic group of leaders God has given us and it has been great fun working alongside them in the lives of some new and returning students. Do pray for them as a number have some big decisions coming up about where God is leading them to minister during the coming years. We ourselves have worked hard this term to find a better blend of family and ministry life this past term. Debs joined the Christmas choir at church and has been meeting regularly with a long standing friend for mutual encouragement. Steve has been undertaking a number of building and maintenance projects in the garden and has really enjoyed getting his teeth into that. Our main hope and desire for 2014 is to continue with this more sustainable pace of life in the midst of the opportunities God is giving us for ministry here in Southampton and beyond.

## Developments in the ministry...

**Southampton Student Ministry** – The thing about student ministry is that there is constant change. By nature most students come and go on a fairly frequent basis (approx. 3-4 years). Last summer a significant number of the group graduated while another significant proportion (all language students) left for a year abroad. This has had a big impact on the make-up of the group and while we have had new people to both the Wednesday and Thursday groups the ministry feels very different this year. Our Bible study groups have been studying Mark's gospel together and will soon be moving on to study some themes under the title of "Freedom in Christ" including Knowing God, idolatry, Understanding our Identity, Relationships, Struggling with sin and Spiritual warfare. Please pray for Steve as he puts the materials together over the next couple of weeks. Please also continue to pray for the development of the various Bible study groups. Please pray too for our Thursday IGNITE group as this has struggled to recruit new people this year. We do however give thanks for a Mexican student who has been coming most weeks and is working through a number of big questions about faith that arose for him last summer.

**Summer Trip (Jul to Aug 2014)** – Despite the sadness of last summer we are eager to continue taking teams on short term mission trips and are currently working on the specifics of the trip. We are sad to report that we have stepped down from our role at Zosna camp in Latvia. A number of factors contributed to this decision including a sense of God leading us on, timings associated with Ben being at school and a sense of others having taken things forward in our absence last year. We are grateful for the 7 years we served at Zosna camp and we ourselves and all those we have taken have been so blessed by the experiences we have had there.

In thinking about the coming year we are very eager to return to Norway. Yes there are some sad memories there but over the years it has been a hugely special and restorative place. We are also part of the group that own the Youth Hostel (Elvheim) and last summer Steve joined the hostel's Board. We are therefore planning on running another discipleship week at the end of July which would be open to students and recent graduates from across Europe. We have also been invited by a dear friend to bring a team to Strasbourg, France earlier in July and so we are working on the details of a France-Norway trip from approximately mid-July to mid-August. Please do pray that we would plan wisely and that God would provide students to be part of the team.
