Generations of labourers...

"And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others" (2 Timothy 2:2, TNIV)

At our recent weekend away, Martin Cooper showed the group a photograph of the student ministry he led in Southampton 30 years ago. He talked about some of the people in the picture with whom he was still in contact with and told a number of stories about how God was using them in their different contexts. This got us thinking about our ministry here in Southampton; reflecting on all that we have seen God doing amongst the group and thinking about what we would like to see God do in the lives of the students God has given us, past, present and future. We have been involved with helping students in Southampton since we served on the Connect Programme (Steve 00-01 and Debs 02-03). In 05-06 Gez and Alison Perry took a back seat in the ministry as they prepared for a move to France and they asked us to take more responsibility for the group. We officially took responsibility for the ministry from 05-06 and along with our graduate team have been running the group since then.

A lot has happened in the group over the past decade; a total of 15 people have served on the Connect Programme in Southampton, and many students have come through the group. Some have moved away to be involved in full-time ministry around the world (Manchester, Oxford, India, France, Malaysia, sailing on MV Doulos); many have continued to serve God in their spheres of influence (home, workplace, neighbourhood). We count it a great privilege and joy to be involved with so many people at such a crucial stage in their lives.

Paul in 2 Tim 2:2 charged Timothy with the task of passing on the baton, the task of entrusting all that Paul had taught him to faithful, reliable and trustworthy people who in turn would be able to pass it on to others. The Navigator calling is "To advance the gospel of Jesus and His kingdom into the nations through spiritual generations of labourers living and discipling among the lost". As we reflect on the past decade it is humbling to see the way that God has been using both us and others to invest in generations of people who share a heart to work amongst God's harvest-field. A significant portion of our current leadership team have been with us since we took responsibility for the group in 05 and it is particularly exciting and a real blessing to see them investing in the next generation...

So much has happened this term and there is only space here to give you a glimpse of what God is doing in us and through us. We have been especially encouraged that there has been a consistent group on Monday evenings talking about big questions such as 'does God exist?', 'what about other religions?' and 'the problem of pain'. Thursday night Bible studies have been encouraging with numbers regularly around 25 people. We have been studying Jesus' parables in Luke's gospel and have found them very stimulating.

In October Steve began his course in Ministry and Theology (FFM) and has been enjoying studying modules such as 'Knowing the Bible: Old Testament', 'Evangelism in theory and Practice', 'Church History' and 'Understanding and Using the Bible'. Debs' Discipleship Explored course at church has now ended but it been a good opportunity to get to know some other mums better.
