
Handout: Am I accepted? True Belonging REFUEL IV: Sat 25 Nov with Steve McClure



AIMS: Acceptance is a huge issue in our world especially for those who've experienced alienation, discrimination or some mind of relational breakdown in our families. (1) We will consider 3 case studies to help us consider the reality we face in finding true belonging. (2) We will see that true acceptance is only found in Christ. (3) Practically we will think about how relationship with God transforms our sense of belonging as we begin to see God as our good Father and ourselves as His sons & daughters.



Introduction: Defining our Terms

Discussion: In what ways do we, our communities and/or society accept or reject one another? What basis is applied for such acceptance or rejection (E.g., Gender, Sexuality, Culture/Race or Status)?

Discussion: Spend some time re-reading the lyrics of Ed Sheeran's song and think about the following questions: What is the central message of the song? What does the song have to say about acceptance/belonging?
